The California Insurance Commissioner as the Conservator of National Automobile and Casualty Insurance Company (hereafter referred to as the "Company") recently applied to the Los Angeles Superior Court for an Order of Liquidation for the Company. The Commissioner's application was granted on April 23, 2002. The Commissioner is now responsible for conducting an orderly liquidation and winding-up the insurance business of the Company pursuant to the Liquidation Order and the California Insurance Code.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT, pursuant to the Liquidation Order of the Court, all insurance policies (excluding bail bonds) issued by the Company have been cancelled effective thirty (30) days following the issuance of the Liquidation Order, unless the policies had previously expired, cancelled or terminated, pursuant to their terms. All insurance coverage and all liabilities on the part of the Company under your client's policy will terminate at 12:01 a.m. on May 23, 2002, unless the policy had previously expired, cancelled, or terminated under the specific terms of the policy. Records reflect that you were a mortgagee on certain policies issued through the Company.

You may want to contact your client and ascertain the name of their new insurance carrier.
