15 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Application is granted and that:

16 1. The Liquidator is authorized to enter into the Archival Materials Agreement with
17 University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) Library and to transfer to the UCLA Library all of
18 Golden State’s right, title and interest in certain historical materials owned by Golden State and
19 identified in the Archival Materials Agreement as the GSM Archival Collection, pursuant to the
20 terms of the Archival Materials Agreement by and between the Liquidator and UCLA Library;

22 2. The Liquidator is authorized to take any and all actions necessary to accomplish
23 the purposes of this Order.
