The verified Application for Order of Liquidation of 19 Respondent National Service Insurance Company came on regularly for t treety 20 hearing on May 4. 1989, in Department 35 of the above entitled 21 court, the Honorable William 6. Po liam O. Pate, Judge presiding. Applicant 22 appeared by her counsel, John K. Van De Kamp, Attorney General of 23 the State of California, by Arthur C. De Goede, Assistant Attorney 24 General: there being no documents filed in response to said 25 Application or other appearance, and after considering the 26 Application and the arguments of counsel:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. 1. The Insurance Commissioner of the State of

1 California is appointed in her official capacity as Liquidator of 2 Respondent, National Service Insurance Company, as prescribed by 3 Section 1016 of the Insurance Code, and directed as Liquidator to 4 liquidate and wind up the affairs of Respondent and to act in all 5 ways and exercise all powers necessary for the purpose of carrying 6 out such order:

- 2. Title to all assets of Respondent now in the 8 possession of the Insurance Commissioner as Conservator hereof, as 9 well as title to any assets of said Respondent discovered hereafter 10 is hereby vested in said Liquidator;
- 3. Said Liquidator, as such, is hereby authorized to 11 12 honor as expenses of administration, all expenses heretofore 13 incurred by the Conservator of Respondent and presently unpaid and 14 is hereby authorized to pay the full amount of any checks or drafts 15 which have been issued by the Conservator of Respondent and which 16 are presently outstanding and unpaid when said checks or drafts are 17 presented for payment;
- 4. The rights and liabilities of creditors, policyholders, 18 19 shareholders, and all other persons interested in the assets of 20 Respondent, including the State of California, are fixed as of the 21 date of this order;
- 5. Respondent, its officers, directors, agents and 23 employees and all other persons are hereby enjoined and restrained 24 from transacting any of the business of Respondent or the 25 disposition of any of its assets and property;

6. All persons are hereby enjoined and restrained from 27 interference with the possession, title and rights of Applicant, as 28 Liquidator, in and to the assets of Respondent, and from

1 interference with the conduct of the liquidator in winding up of 2 the business of Respondent;

- 7. All persons are hereby enjoined from the waste of 4 assets of Respondent;
- 8. All persons are hereby enjoined from instituting or 6 prosecuting any action or proceedings against Respondent, or 7 Applicant as Liquidator of Respondent, without the consent of this 8 court obtained after reasonable notice to said Liquidator;
- 9. All persons are hereby enjoined from obtaining 10 preferences, judgments, attachments or other liens, or making any 11 levy against Respondent or its assets without the consent of this 12 Court obtained after reasonable notice to said Liquidator;
- 10. All officers, directors, agents and employees of 14 Respondent are hereby ordered to deliver to said Liquidator all 15 assets, books, records, equipment and other property of said 16 Respondent:
- 11. All funds and bank accounts in the name of 18 Respondent, or Applicant as Conservator, are hereby vested in said 19 Liquidator and said funds shall be subject to withdrawal from said 20 banks upon the order of said Liquidator only;
- 12. All insurance agents and brokers are hereby ordered 22 to account to the Liquidator of Respondent for all funds of 23 Respondent held by them in their fiduciary capacity, as specified 24 in Sections 1733, 1734 and 1735 of the Insurance Code, or due to 25 Respondent, and directed to forward said funds to Applicant as 26 Liquidator, and said funds are vested in Applicant as Liquidator; 27 and

13. Said Liquidator is hereby authorized to initiate such 2 equitable or legal actions or proceedings in this or other states 3 as may appear to her necessary to carry out her function as Liquidator.
