1 The Verified Application for Order Approving Liquidator’s Proposal to Disburse Assets
2 to State Insurance Guarantee Associations or Funds of the Insurance Commissioner of the State
3 of California, in his capacity as Liquidator of Fremont Indemnity Company (“Liquidator”), was
4 heard in Department 307 of the above-entitled court, on July 7, 2005, at 8:30 a.m., the Honorable
5 Wendell Mortimer, Jr., presiding. Having read and considered the Application, the Memorandum
6 of Points and Authorities submitted in support thereof and, argument having been heard and good
7 cause appearing,

8 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

9 1. The Application is granted;

10 2. The Liquidator is authorized to disburse \$36,934,280 of the assets of Fremont
11 Indemnity Company in liquidation to the state insurance guarantee associations or funds, subject
12 to final adjustments of the disbursement amount; and

13 3. The Liquidator is authorized to take any and all action necessary to accomplish the
14 purposes of this Order.
