The Court has reviewed and considered the *Insurance Commissioner's Motion for* Approval of Transaction ("Motion") filed by California Insurance Commissioner Dave Jones ("Commissioner") in his capacity as the Statutory Liquidator ("Liquidator") of CastlePoint National Insurance Company ("CastlePoint"), as supplemented in *Insurance* Commissioner's Statement of Lack of Opposition to Motion for Approval of Transaction and Update, filed on April 5, 2018, and the Insurance Commissioner's Supplemental Statement in Support of Unopposed Motion for Approval of Transaction and Transaction Update, filed on May 9, 2018. Based on its review and consideration of the Motion, as supplemented, the concurrently filed supporting Memorandum of Points and Authorities, the Declaration of David E. Wilson, and all other pleadings, papers and records filed with the Court, and the facts and circumstances stated therein, as well as any evidence and arguments presented to the Court, and upon good cause shown, the Court hereby finds that:

- No responses or objections to the Motion have been filed. A.
- The notice provided of the Motion constitutes notice that is appropriate B. under the particular circumstances and complies with the applicable provisions of the California Insurance Code, and no other notice need be given.
- Good cause exists to approve the Motion and the Transaction contemplated C. thereby, and the terms and conditions of the Transaction are (i) fair and reasonable and (ii) will be valid, binding and enforceable when entered into by the parties to the Transaction.
- D. The approval of the Transaction sought in the Motion is reasonable, appropriate, and necessary to the orderly and timely liquidation of CastlePoint, and is in the best interests of policyholders, creditors and other parties interested in the liquidation of CastlePoint.

The Transaction set forth in the Motion, as supplemented, and accompanying Memorandum of Points and Authorities, is hereby approved, and the Commissioner shall have the authority and discretion to enter into the Transaction as well as to enter into all other related agreements and take any other actions necessary to effectuate the Transaction.
- 3. This Order is self-executing and no further notice or hearing shall be required hereon.
