STIPULATION AND [PROPOSED]
ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT
AND COMMUTATION AGREEMENT
WITH THE UNITED STATES LIFE
INSURANCE COMPANY AND
LIQUIDATOR OF THE SUPERIOR
NATIONAL ESTATES

The Honorable Steve Poizner, Insurance Commissioner of the State of California, ("Commissioner") in his capacity as liquidator of Superior National Insurance Company, Superior Pacific Casualty Company, California Compensation Insurance Company, Combined Benefits Insurance Company, and Commercial Compensation Casualty ("Liquidator") (which five insurers are hereinafter referenced as the "Superior National Insurance Companies in Liquidation" or "SNICIL"), and third party The United States Life Insurance Company in the City of New York ("US Life") (collectively, the "Parties"), subject to Court confirmation and approval, hereby stipulate as follows:

1. The Parties acknowledge that the SNICIL insurers are reinsured under a reinsurance contract issued by US Life entitled Workers' Compensation Quota Share Treaty effective May 1, 1998 (the "US Life Treaty").

2. In June 1999, pursuant to California Insurance Code §§ 11690-11703, US
Life established an account under the control of the Commissioner to secure its obligations under
the US Life Treaty (the "Special Schedule P Account"). The purpose of the Special Schedule P
Account is to secure US Life's obligations under the US Life Treaty with respect to ceded losses.

- 3. The Parties entered into a Settlement and Commutation Agreement dated November 23, 2010 ("Agreement") for the purpose of settling and commuting all of US Life's existing and future obligations under the US Life Treaty. Upon approval of this Agreement and satisfaction of US Life's payment obligation under the Agreement, US Life is released from any and all further obligations to SNICIL and the Liquidator under the US Life Treaty. The current balance in the Special Schedule P Account has a par value of \$176,015,000 and US Life's payment obligation under the Agreement is \$139,399,436.
- Agreement shall be satisfied from funds held in the Special Schedule P Account and US Life shall have no further obligations under the May 1, 1998 Treaty to be secured by the remaining balance in the Special Schedule P Account. Accordingly, as soon as this Stipulation and [Proposed] Order is "so ordered" by the Court, US Life shall satisfy its payment obligations under the Agreement from the funds in the US Life Special Schedule P Account and the Liquidator and US Life shall notify the Commissioner in his official capacity that: (i) the Commissioner sis authorized to draw and receive funds held on deposit in the Special Schedule P Account in the amount of \$139,399,436 for distribution to the Liquidator in full satisfaction of US Life's payment obligations under the Agreement; and (ii) that all obligations under the May 1, 1998 Treaty have been fully satisfied or otherwise discharged and US Life's statutory requirement to maintain a Special Schedule P deposit for these obligations have been released; and that the Liquidator has no objections to the release of the balance of the Special Schedule P deposit to US Life after distribution to the Commissioner as set forth in (i) above. The distributions shall be made by wire transfer to the following accounts:
