- 2. The Insurance Commissioner as Liquidator of Pacific States Casualty Company ("Liquidator") is authorized to distribute \$2,000 to the Class IV claimant;
- 3. The Liquidator is authorized to distribute \$1,387,174 pro rata to all Class V claimants. The amount available for distribution is subject to adjustment the sums received from investment income and changes in market value of investments that have been posted as of the date the investments are withdrawn from the investment pool;
- 4. Upon entry of the requested order, the Liquidator is authorized to immediately deposit in the State Treasury pursuant & Section 1056.5 of the flux Code escheat to the State of California the respective distributions to Class V claimants with undeliverable addresses in accordance with Code of Civil Procedure section 1500 et seq.;
- 5. The Liquidator shall retain the sum of \$115,359 for payment of administrative expenses incurred by the Liquidator from and after November 30, 2002 and the Liquidator is authorized to pay any excess closing and administrative costs out of the funds appropriated for the maintenance of the Department of Insurance. A report to the Court of the expenditure of these funds shall not be required;
- 6. The Liquidator is authorized to maintain all records of Pacific States Casualty

 Company for five years from the date of this order and thereafter the Liquidator is authorized to
