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The Insurance Commissioner of the State of California's Application for Orders: (1)
Settling and Approving Final Report and Account of Liquidator of Pacific National Insurance
Company; (2) Authorizing Disbursement of Funds; (3) Approving Payment of Expenses; and (4)
Terminating Proceeding and Discharging Liquidator ("Application") came on for hearing on
December 17, 2014, at 1:30 p.m. in Department C31 of the above entitled court, the Honorable
Frederick P. Horn, presiding.

The Court, after reviewing the Application, the Memorandum of Points and Authorities, the exhibits and declarations submitted in support thereof, and argument having been heard and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The Report and Account of Liquidator for the period from May 14, 2003, through September 30, 2014, is settled and approved.
- 2. The Commissioner is authorized to distribute \$3,835,458 to CIGA as the approved Class 2 claimant. The amount available for distribution is subject to adjustment for investment income and changes in market value of investments that have been posted as of the date the investments are withdrawn from the investment pool. The distributions shall be made within two weeks of receipt of the signed order from the Court.
- 3. The Commissioner will retain the sum of \$2,000,000 for payment of administrative expenses incurred by the Commissioner from and after September 30, 2014, for administrative closing costs including a material provision for a potential federal tax liability. The Commissioner is further authorized to distribute any surplus amount, reserved for payment of post-closing administrative expenses and federal income taxes, to the approved Class 2 claimant. A report to the Court of the expenditure of these funds shall not be required.
- 4. The Commissioner is authorized to destroy all records of Pacific National in his custody and control, except for those records necessary for examination by the Department of Finance or other auditor of the Commissioner's books and records pursuant to Insurance Code section 1061.
