

NOTICE OF COURT ORDER
REGARDING SUBPOENAS AND PHOTOCOPY REQUESTS ISSUED

Please be advised that on May __, 2003, Los Angeles County Superior Court Judge Carl J. West issued an Order entitled "Order Authorizing Liquidator To Cease Responding To Third Party Subpoenas And Photocopy Requests Issued By Workers' Compensation Appeals Board And Others," which provides in pertinent part:

1. That the Insurance Commissioner of the State of California in his capacity as Liquidator ("Liquidator") of Superior National Insurance Company, Superior Pacific Casualty Company, California Compensation Insurance Company, Combined Benefits Insurance Company and Commercial Compensation Casualty Company is authorized to cease responding to subpoenas and photocopy requests from third parties (parties not in litigation with the Liquidator) issued by the Workers Compensation Appeals Board and other entities.
2. That the Order is made without prejudice to a third parties' ability to file an application in Department 311-CCW of the Los Angeles County Superior Court for relief from the Order. A third party or its counsel may contact Department 311-CCW at Telephone No. 213-351-8610 to schedule a hearing on an application. The application must demonstrate good cause including a showing that the information and/or documents sought from the Liquidator is not available from any other sources including but not limited to the Workers Compensation Appeals Board, medical providers and employers. 26 The Liquidator's Application For Order Authorizing Liquidator To Cease Responding To
 27 Third Party Subpoenas And Photocopy Requests Issued By Workers Compensation Appeals
 28 Board and Others came on for hearing on April 16, 2003 in Los Angeles County Superior Court,

1 Department 311-CCW, the Honorable Carl J. West, Judge, presiding. The Liquidator was
2 represented by his counsel, Bill Lockyer, Attorney General by Michael R. Weiss, Deputy
3 Attorney General. Other appearances are noted in the record.

4 The Court after reviewing the Liquidator's Application For Order Authorizing Liquidator
5 To Cease Responding To Third Party Subpoenas And Photocopy Requests Issued By Workers
6 Compensation Appeals Board and Others, and the Memorandum of Points & Authorities and
7 Declarations submitted in support thereof, all of which having been filed directly in Department
8 311-CCW of the above-entitled Court and served on all parties on March 17, 2003, and the last
9 day to file and serve an objection or opposition to said Application having been April 3, 2003
10 and no objection or opposition having been filed as of that date, and argument having been heard
11 and good cause appearing, ORDERS THAT:

12 1. The Liquidator is authorized to cease responding to subpoenas and photocopy
13 requests from third parties (parties not in litigation with the Liquidator) issued by the Workers
14 Compensation Appeals Board and other entities;

15 2. This Order is made without prejudice to such third parties' ability to file an
16 application with Department 311-CCW of the above-entitled court for relief from this Order.
17 The application must demonstrate good cause including a showing that the information and/or
18 documents sought from the Liquidator is not available from any other sources including but not
19 limited to the Workers Compensation Appeals Board, medical providers and employers;

20 3. The Liquidator is ordered to serve a copy of this Order and the Notice attached
21 hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A" on all third parties with subpoenas and photocopy
22 requests issued by the Workers Compensation Appeals Board and other entities currently
23 pending with the Liquidator and on all third parties who in the future serve on the Liquidator
24 subpoenas and photocopy requests issued by the Workers Compensation Appeals Board and
25 other entities; and


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1 4. The Liquidator is authorized to take any and all action necessary to accomplish
