- 2. The statements contained in this declaration are not all within my personal knowledge, and I am informed that no single officer of the CLO has personal knowledge of all of these matters. The statements in this declaration are based upon information assembled by authorized employees of the CLO, and I am informed and believe that the statements based upon that information are true. As to those matters that are within my own personal knowledge, the statements are true. I have reviewed the CLO files for Paula, which are maintained in the normal course of business.
- 3. I am responsible for the management of financially impaired or insolvent insurance companies (referred to as "estates") from the time of conservation or liquidation until the court has discharged the Insurance Commissioner of his or her duties as Conservator or Liquidator. I serve as a fiduciary, and in this capacity, I lead and direct a support team consisting of individuals who work in the areas of Accounting, Claims, Reinsurance, Legal, Finance, Information

 Technology, Human Resources, and Administration. Once the California Insurance

 Commissioner identifies an insurance company as financially impaired or at risk of mismanaging its assets, he files an application with the court for conservation or liquidation of the company.

 As an ETO, I receive input and advice from other insurance professionals, including attorneys from the California Department of Insurance, the California Attorney General's Office, and private law firms.
