24	1. I am an Estate Trust Manager of the Insurance Commissioner of the State of						
25	California's Conservation & Liquidation Office (CLO). I am the employee responsible for						
26	managing the affairs of Superior National Insurance Company and the related entities, Superior						
27	Pacific Casualty Company, California Compensation Insurance Company, Commercial						
28	Compensation Casualty Company and Combined Benefits Insurance Company (collectively,

Insolvent Insurers), which are under the supervision of the Commissioner in his capacity as its
liquidator.

2. As the Estate Trust Manager, I have primary responsibility for the overall			
administration of all insolvent insurance companies (referred to as "estates"), including the			
Insolvent Insurers, from the time of conservation or liquidation until the court has discharged the			
Insurance Commissioner of his or her duties as Conservator or Liquidator. I serve as a fiduciary,			
and in this capacity, I lead and direct a support team consisting of individuals who work in the			
areas of Accounting, Claims, Reinsurance, Legal, Finance, Information Technology, Human			
Resources, and Administration. I am also responsible for the management of the Insolvent			
Insurers' books and records, and I have overall custody and control thereof. This declaration is			
based on my personal knowledge as well as my review of the books and records of the Insolvent			
Insurers.			
3. On August 31, 2021, the Court entered the Order (1) Settling and Approving Final			
Report and Account of the Liquidator; (2) Authorizing Disbursement of Funds; (3) Approving			
Payment of Expenses; and (4) Terminating Liquidation Proceeding and Discharging Insurance			
Commissioner as Liquidator (Order).			
4. The Order provided that the Liquidator shall be discharged as the liquidator of the			
Insolvent Insurers upon his filing of a declaration that he distributed the assets of the Insolvent			
Insurers in accordance with the terms of the Order.			
5. On October 15, 2021, the Liquidator made the following distributions:			
a. \$36,397,566.55 to approved Class 2 claimants of Superior National			
Insurance Company;			
b. \$17,190,516.70 to approved Class 2 claimants of California Compensation			
Insurance Company;			
c. \$7,750,042.13 to approved Class 2 and 7 claimants of Combined Benefits			
Insurance Company;			
d. \$14,164,183.94 to approved Class 2 claimants of Commercial			
Compensation Casualty Company; and			

1	e. \$16,948,903.62 to approved Class 2 claimants of Superior Pacific Casualty				
2	Company.				
3	6. All amounts distributed by the Liquidator have been negotiated or escheated				
4	pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 1517.				
5	7. The Liquidator retained \$1,131,770.75 for payment of administrative closing				
6	expenses and costs as provided by the Order.				
7	8. The Liquidator having taken all action necessary pursuant to the terms of the
