Hill Street, Los Angeles, California 90012 ("Court"), Applicant Insurance Commissioner of the State of California ("Commissioner") in his capacity as Liquidator and former capacity as Conservator of Golden State Mutual Life Insurance Company ("Golden State"), will and hereby does submit its Revised Application pursuant to Court Orders dated September 13 and October 26, 2012 for:

- 1. A Court Order approving the Commissioner's expenses for eight consultants and vendors for the twenty-seven month period from September 30, 2009 through December 31, 2011; and
- 2. A Court Order authorizing the Commissioner to take any and all actions necessary to accomplish the purposes of the above requested Order.

## **Grounds for the Application**

By Order dated September 13, 2012, the Honorable Robert H. O'Brien granted in part and denied in part the Application To Approve Conservation and Liquidation Expenses ("First Application") filed by the Commissioner. Specifically, the First Application was granted in part as to the fees and expenses for eight of the fifteen consultants/vendors requested in the Application, for a total of \$3,001,098.18. The eight consultants whose fees and expenses were previously approved by the Court are:

The Court did not approve the fees and expenses of seven consultants/vendors requested in the Application based upon documentation deficiencies that the Court at that time concluded undermine a proper initial determination of the propriety of the fees. The non-approved fees and expenses are not included in this Revised Application and will be the subject of a separate application for approval entitled Second Application To Approve Conservation And Liquidation Expenses.

At the conclusion of its September 13, 2012 Order, the Court instructed the Commissioner to submit a "revised" amount for approval minus the amounts not approved. Thereafter, by Order dated October 26, 2012, the Court instructed the Commissioner to resubmit its First Application "excising the disapproved amounts." By this Revised Application and pursuant to the Court's orders, the Commissioner hereby re-submits his First Application and seeks an order approving the fees and expenses for the eight consultants/vendors stated above which were approved by the Court.

The delay between the October 26, 2012 Order and the filing of this Revised Application is due to the Commissioner's now dismissed appeal of Judge O'Brien's September 13 and October 26, 2012 Orders. On November 9, 2012, due to Judge O'Brien's non-approval of the fees and expenses of seven consultants/vendors, the Commissioner filed a Notice of Appeal to preserve appellate rights. Thereafter, on November 20, 2012, in accordance with the October 26 Order, the Commissioner previously filed this Revised Application seeking approval of the expenses for the eight vendors whose expenses were approved in the September 13th Order. However, on January 9, 2013, at the hearing on said Revised Application, Judge O'Brien declined to hear the application on the basis that the Notice of Appeal divested the Court of jurisdiction as to all matters addressed in the Orders including the eight vendors whose fees were approved. The Court thereafter issued a minute order stating that the application is "stayed pending appeal."

Now, after further research and review of the Court's September 13 and October 26 Orders, the Commissioner has concluded that the Orders are non-final, non-appealable interim receivership orders for which additional documentation and information can be submitted to support the fees and expenses incurred. Accordingly, on August 29, 2013, the Commissioner dismissed the appeal.

This application is made pursuant to *In re Executive Life Insurance Company* (1995) 32 Cal.App.4<sup>th</sup> 344, Insurance Code § 1037 and the Orders of conservation and liquidation for Golden State, on the grounds that the above-described fees and expenses were necessary for the conservation and liquidation of Golden State, are within the Commissioner's broad discretion and authorities under the Court's Order of Liquidation, the Insurance Code and case law, and are reasonable for the services performed. Court approval of the expenses and fees is appropriate.

This application is based on this Notice, the Memorandum of Points and Authorities and the declarations of Scott Pearce and Michael R. Weiss, and evidence filed concurrently with this Notice, the pleadings, documents and papers on file in this action, and on such oral and/or documentary evidence and arguments which may be presented at the hearing on this application.
