DECLARATION OF COMPLIANCE OF LIQUIDATOR CONFIRMING DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS PURSUANT TO COURT ORDER AND CLOSING THE ESTATE OF FRONTIER PACIFIC INSURANCE COMPANY

## I, WILLARD ROBERTS, declare:

- I am employed as an Estate Trust Officer for the California
   Insurance Commissioner's ("Commissioner" or "Liquidator") Conservation &
   Liquidation Office ("CLO).
- 2. As an Estate Trust Officer, I am responsible for the management of financially impaired or insolvent insurance companies (referred to as "estates") from the time of conservation or liquidation until the court has discharged the Commissioner of his or her duties as Conservator or Liquidator. I serve as a fiduciary, and in this capacity, I lead and direct a

support team consisting of individuals who work in the areas of Accounting, Claims, Reinsurance, Legal, Finance, Information Technology, Human Resources, and Administration.

- 3. The statements contained in this declaration are not all within my personal knowledge, and I am informed that no single officer of the CLO has personal knowledge of all of these matters. As to those matters that are within my own personal knowledge, the statements are true. Those statements in this declaration that are not based on my personal knowledge are based upon information assembled by authorized employees of the CLO and retained in CLO files for the Frontier Pacific Insurance Company ("FPIC") estate. As to any matters stated on information and belief, I am informed and believe they are true. If called upon as a witness, I would testify as set forth herein.
- 4. I am the Estate Trust Officer responsible for managing the affairs of FPIC in liquidation. I have primary responsibility for the overall administration for the FPIC estate, including, but not limited to, matters pertaining to the FPIC estate's financial reporting, claims administration, legal matters, reinsurance, and estate expenditures. I am also responsible for the management of the FPIC estate's books and records, and I have overall custody and control thereof.
- 5. On June 23, 2015, the Court entered an order: (1) Approving Final Report and Account of Conservator and Liquidator; (2) Approving Final Distribution of Assets and (3) Closing the Estate (hereinafter "Order").
- 6. The Order provides that the estate shall be closed and the Commissioner shall be discharged as liquidator of FPIC upon his filing of a declaration that he distribute the assets of the FPIC estate in accordance with the terms of the Order.

- 7. As of July 8, 2015, the Commissioner completed its final distribution of assets of the FPIC estate by distributing \$5,065,269.20 to the California Insurance Guarantee Association, \$843,767.68 to the New York Liquidation Bureau and \$5,701,562.25 to the non-guaranty association claimants under Insurance Code section 1033, subdivision (a)(2).
- 8. Of the \$5,701,562.25 distributed to the non-guaranty association claimants, and in accordance with the Code of Civil Procedure section 1517, the Commissioner escheated \$487,830.90 to the Insurance Fund representing all undeliverable amounts and amounts of non-negotiated checks.
- 9. Pursuant to the Order, the Commissioner retained \$271,055 as its reserve closing budget from payment of administrative and closing costs.
- 10. The Commissioner has taken all action necessary pursuant to the terms of the order. The FPIC liquidation estate shall be closed and the Commissioner considers himself discharged as the Liquidator the FPIC estate according to the terms of the Order.
