Rylaarsdam, Judge presiding. Daniel E. 21 Lungren, Attorney General of the State of California, by Edmond B. 22 Mamer, Supervising Deputy Attorney General, appeared for 23 Applicant. Joseph K. Hegedus of Lewis, D'Amato, Brisbois & 24 Bisgaard appeared for Respondent. The matter having been argued 25 and submitted for decision on the papers and files herein and good 26

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cause appearing therefore, the court finds that Respondent,

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Western International Insurance Company is insolvent.

## WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. The Insurance Commissioner of the State of California is appointed in his official capacity as Liquidator of Respondent, Western International Insurance Company, and directed to liquidate and wind up the affairs of Respondent and to act in all ways and exercise all powers necessary for the purpose of carrying out such order, as provided by applicable law;
- 2. Title to all assets of Respondent now in the possession of the Insurance Commissioner as Conservator hereof, as well as title to any assets of said Respondent discovered hereafter is hereby vested in said Liquidator;
- 3. Said Liquidator, as such, is hereby authorized to pay as expenses of administration, all expenses heretofore incurred by the Conservator of Respondent and presently unpaid and is hereby authorized to pay the full amount of any checks or drafts which have been issued by the Conservator of Respondent and which are presently outstanding and unpaid when said checks or drafts are presented for payment;
- 4. The rights and liabilities of claimants, creditors, and all other persons interested in the assets of Respondent, including the State of California, are fixed as of the date of entry of this order;
- 5. Respondent, its officers, directors, agents and employees and all other persons are hereby enjoined from transacting any of the business of Respondent or disposing of any of its California assets or property or any other assets or property of Respondent wheresoever situated;

- 7. All persons are hereby enjoined from waste of assets of Respondent;
- 8. All persons are hereby enjoined from instituting or prosecuting or maintaining any action at law or suit in equity against Respondent, or Applicant as Liquidator of Respondent, without the consent of this court obtained after reasonable notice to said Liquidator;
- 9. All persons are hereby enjoined from obtaining preferences, judgments, attachments or other liens, or making any levy against Respondent or its assets without the consent of this court obtained after reasonable notice to said Liquidator;
- 10. All officers, directors, agents and employees of Respondent are hereby ordered to deliver all books, records, equipment and other assets of Respondent wheresoever situated to said Liquidator;
- 11. All funds and bank accounts in the name of Respondent, or Applicant as Conservator, in various banks or in any other bank wheresoever situated, are vested in Applicant as Liquidator and subject to withdrawal upon his order only;
- 12. All insurance agents and brokers in the State of California are hereby ordered to account to Applicant as Liquidator of Respondent for all funds of Respondent held by them in their fiduciary capacity, as specified in Sections 1733, 1734

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and 1735 of the Insurance Code, or due to Respondent, and that said funds are vested in Applicant as Liquidator, and said funds are to be forwarded by such insurance agents and brokers to said Liquidator unless otherwise directed by the Liquidator; and

The Liquidator is authorized to initiate such equitable 13. or legal actions or proceedings in this or other states as may appear to him necessary to carry out his functions as Liquidator.
