NOTICE OF CONTINUED HEARING DATE AND CHANGE IN PROPOSED DISTRIBUTION

Dear Claimants:

The Insurance Commissioner, as Liquidator of HIH America Compensation & Liability Company, noticed a hearing for his Application for Order Approving Payment of Liquidator's Expenses, Approving the Final Distribution of Assets, and Closing the Estate, to be held on Thursday, November 19, 2015 at 9:30 a.m. Notice of this Application was mailed to you on October 13, 2015.

The Application included a breakdown of the proposed payment of each claim, as contained in Exhibit B to the Declaration of Ray Minehan filed in support thereof. Each claimant would receive approximately 55.42% of its claim. The Application also stated the Liquidator had estimated a closing budget of \$289,313, which he would hold in reserve.

Unfortunately, the Liquidator's office underestimated the closing budget by \$200,000. Accordingly, the Liquidator has to reduce the proposed distribution to each claimant by a *de minimis* amount to make up for the shortfall. The Liquidator has proposed that each claimant receive 55.39% of their claim, rather than 55.42% of their claim. See, Supplemental Declaration of Ray Minehan, enclosed. The difference between the original proposed amount of payment, and the current proposed payment, for each claim is contained in Amended Exhibit B, enclosed.

The original proposed order contained the inaccurate numbers, and therefore the Liquidator is withdrawing the original proposed order. The Liquidator proposes that the Court sign the Amended Proposed Order, which is enclosed.

The Court has continued the November 19, 2015 to December 31, 2015 at 9:30 a.m., in order to allow the Liquidator to provide notice to all interested claimants of the change in the proposed distribution and the change in the proposed order. **A hearing will take place on December 31, 2015 at 9:30 a.m. in Department 302 of the San Francisco Superior Court, located at 400 McAllister Street, Third Floor, on the Liquidator's Application, and Amended Proposed Order.**

1 The Insurance Commissioner as Liquidator of HIH America Compensation & Liability
2 Insurance Company (also "Liquidator"), has applied for an order approving the payment of
3 administrative expenses, the final distribution of assets, and the closing of the liquidated estate of
4 HIH America Compensation & Liability Insurance Company (the HIH America estate").

5 Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

6 1. The Liquidator's payment of \$306,812 for general operating and administrative
7 expenses for the HIH America estate paid from July 1, 2014 through May 31, 2015 is approved;

8 2. The Liquidator is authorized to distribute approximately \$14,464,052.90
9 to the applicable state insurance guaranty associations ("IGAs") and \$359,355.10 to the Non-
10 IGA claimants under Insurance Code section 1033, subdivision (a)(2). The distributions shall be
11 made within two weeks of receipt of the signed order from the Court;

12 3. The Liquidator is authorized to retain the sum of \$489,313 as its reserve closing
13 budget for payment of administrative expenses incurred but not yet paid by the Liquidator as of
14 May 31, 2015, and for future administrative and closing costs. The Liquidator is authorized to pay
15 any excess closing and administrative costs out of the funds appropriated for the maintenance of
16 the Department of Insurance. A report to the Court of the expenditure of these funds shall not be
17 required;

18 4. As to disbursements that are either undeliverable or as to issued checks that have
19 not been negotiated, the Liquidator is authorized to void such checks and escheat all
20 undeliverable amounts and amounts of non-negotiated checks to the Insurance Fund pursuant to
21 Code of Civil Procedure section 1517.

22 5. In the absence of any IGA objection, the Liquidator is authorized to initiate the
23 destruction of physical records associated with the HIH America estate, while continuing to
24 maintain electronic records for a period of three years following the Court's issuance of this
25 Order, except for electronic records necessary for examination by the Department of Finance or
26 state auditor;

27 6. The Insurance Commissioner is authorized to maintain in the Conservation &
28 Liquidation Office imaged databases of all records of HIH America for a period of three years

1 from the date of this Court's Order, and thereafter the Insurance Commissioner is authorized to
2 destroy all records of HIH America, except for those records necessary for examination by the
3 Department of Finance or the auditor of the Insurance Commissioner's books and records
4 pursuant to section 1061;

5 7. The estate of HIH America shall be closed and the Insurance Commissioner shall
6 be discharged as Conservator and Liquidator upon the filing of a declaration that the Insurance
7 Commissioner has distributed the assets of HIH America in accordance with this Court's order
8 approving final distribution. The Insurance Commissioner, his Special Deputies, the Conservation
9 and Liquidation Office, its employees, the California Department of Insurance, and its personnel
10 and the Commissioner's agents and attorneys shall be upon such filing DISCHARGED from any
11 and all claims, debts, liabilities, or duties to further account for the assets or liabilities of HIH
12 America through the date of the declaration, and shall have no liability of any kind or nature for
13 such claims or debts; and

14 8. The Insurance Commissioner is authorized to take any and all action necessary to
15 accomplish the purposes of the Order prayed for herein.

25 I, Raymond J. Minehan, declare:

26 1. I make this supplemental declaration in my official capacity as the Chief Financial
27 Officer at the California Insurance Commissioner's Conservation and Liquidation Office

1 (“CLO”). I have served as the Chief Financial Officer of the CLO since May 2005. Previously, I
2 was a Chief Financial Officer and Chief Administrative Officer at two investment banks. Prior to
3 that, I spent 17 years, the last five of which as an audit partner, at Arthur Andersen & Co. I hold
4 a Bachelor of Arts degree in finance from Golden Gate University.

5 2. My duties as the CLO’s Chief Financial Officer include oversight of the CLO
6 Accounting Department and the Human Resources Department. In addition, I am a member of the
7 Executive Committee of the CLO. As the CLO’s Chief Financial Officer, I supervise the
8 preparation of financial statements at the CLO, which are prepared in a systematic manner in the
9 ordinary course of business, with entries being made into those financial statements at or about
10 the time that the events described occur. I am familiar with the documents and files maintained
11 by the CLO pertaining to the records of the insolvent estate of HIH America Compensation and
12 Liability Insurance Company (“HIH America”) and the assets and liabilities of the HIH America
13 estate. I have personal knowledge of the matters contained in this declaration and, if called as a
14 witness to testify, I could and would competently testify to them.

15 3. As explained in my original declaration, in determining the proposed amount to be
16 distributed by the HIH America estate, the Liquidator must project and reserve sufficient assets to
17 provide for the payment of estimated closing expenses of administration. After taking into
18 account the amount included for the proposed distribution, the Liquidator originally reserved a
19 closing budget for the HIH America estate of \$289,313, anticipating that to be sufficient to cover
20 the estate’s final closing costs for the period June 1, 2015 through three years following closure.
21 This reserved sum represented the estimated post-closing expenses of administration such as legal
22 fees, final audits and tax preparation fees and other final administrative expenses. A breakdown
23 of the closing budget was attached as Exhibit D to my original declaration.

24 4. I have since determined that the Estimated Administrative and Closing Budget was
25 underestimated, and a total of \$489,313 is a more accurate estimated Closing Budget. The reason
26 for the requirement for an increase is that the Allocated Expenses portion of the budget, originally
27 projected at \$129,250, should have been projected at \$329,250, thereby increasing the Total
28 Estimated Budget to \$489,313.

1 5. Allocated expenses are indirect CLO administrative expenses that cannot be directly
2 charged to a specific estate but which were allocated to the HIH America estate under a formula
3 based on the ratio of CLO employee hours charged directly to the specific estate to total CLO
4 employee hours charged directly to all estates. CLO compensation expense comprises the largest
5 component of allocated expenses, followed by rent, health insurance, payroll taxes, retirement
6 plan contributions and other employee expenses. The allocated expense portion of the budget
7 was increased beyond what was originally projected because CLO staff spent more hours
8 preparing the estate for closure than what was originally estimated, and because of a longer
9 period of time than projected to have the matter set for hearing. The latter caused an allocation of
10 general overhead for a greater period than was originally anticipated.

11 6. Due to the increase in the estate's Estimated Closing Budget, it became necessary to
12 slightly reduce the distribution percentage on all IGA and non-IGA claims from 55.42% to
13 55.39%. This will result in a distribution of approximately \$14, 464,052.90 to the applicable state
14 insurance guaranty associations ("IGAs") and \$359,355.10 to the Non-IGA claimants under
15 Insurance Code section 1033, subdivision (a)(2). An amended Exhibit B is attached which shows
16 the difference in the originally proposed distribution and the currently proposed distribution. If
17 the Liquidator must re-notice the closing application package and obtain a new hearing date to
18 provide notice of this minor change to the claimants, those efforts will reduce the monies
19 available to the claimants even more, resulting in further reduction of the distribution percentage.
20 I do not believe the closing application should be re-noticed because as I stated in my original
21 declaration, the proposed distributions were an approximation, see ¶ 4 of my original declaration.


