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I, Scott Pearce, declare:

- 1. I am the Senior Estate Trust Officer of the Insurance Commissioner of the State of California's Conservation & Liquidation Office (CLO), and have been employed by the CLO for 16 years. I am the employee responsible for managing the affairs of Fremont Indemnity Company (Fremont), which is under the supervision of the Commissioner in his capacity as its liquidator.
- 2. As the Senior Estate Trust Officer, I have primary responsibility for the overall administration of all insolvent insurance companies (referred to as estates), including Fremont, from the time of conservation or liquidation until the court has discharged the Insurance Commissioner of his or her duties as Conservator or Liquidator. I serve as a fiduciary, and in this capacity, I lead and direct a support team consisting of individuals who work in the areas of Accounting, Claims, Reinsurance, Legal, Finance, Information Technology, Human Resources, and Administration. I am also responsible for the management of Fremont's books and records, and I have overall custody and control thereof. This declaration is based on my personal knowledge as well as my review of the books and records of Fremont.
- 3. On August 14, 2019, the Court entered the Order (1) Settling and Approving Final Report and Account of the Liquidator of Fremont Indemnity Company; (2) Authorizing Disbursement of Funds; (3) Approving Payment of Expenses; and (4) Terminating Liquidation Proceeding and Discharging Insurance Commissioner as Liquidator (Order).
- 4. The Order provided that the Liquidator shall be discharged as the liquidator of Fremont upon his filing of a declaration that he distributed the assets of Fremont in accordance with the terms of the Order.
- 5. On September 26, 2019, the Liquidator made distributions totaling \$83.4 million to approved Class 2 claimants;
- 6. All amounts distributed by the Liquidator have been negotiated with the exception of two payments totaling \$30,243.42. The Liquidator will wait the six-month period provided for in Code of Civil Procedure section 1517, and thereafter void any non-negotiated checks and escheat all undeliverable amounts and amounts of non-negotiated checks to the Insurance Fund.
