28	1. The Insurance Commissioner's motions to reopen the case of <i>Insurance</i>					

Commissioner of the State of California v. Alistar Insurance Company, San Francisco Superior Court No. CGC-05-446011 is granted.

- 2. This case is reopened for the sole and limited purpose of making a final distribution of the money returned by the California Insurance Guarantee Association (CIGA) to the Alistar estate and any funds remaining after the closure of the Alistar estate in 2012.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner is authorized to distribute the funds to the approved Class 2 claimants listed in Exhibit C to the Declaration of Raymond Minehan, in the amounts described therein. A copy of Exhibit C to the Declaration of Raymond Minehan is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and is incorporated herein by reference.
 - 4. The Court's standing injunctions remain in effect.
- 5. The case of *Insurance Commissioner of the State of California v. Alistar Insurance Company*, San Francisco Superior Court No. CGC-05-446011 shall be immediately closed upon the completion of the distribution of the money to the approved Class 2 claimants.
- 6. The Insurance Commissioner is not required to file a declaration of compliance upon completion of the distribution to the approved claimants.
- 7. If there are any assets remaining after the Insurance Commissioner has completed all his closing tasks, e.g., destroying Alistar's records, such remainder shall be escheated to the California Department of Insurance (CDI) in accordance with the procedure agreed upon by the CDI, Conservation and Liquidation Office, and the State Controller's Office.
- 8. The Insurance Commissioner is authorized to take any action necessary to accomplish the purpose of this Order.
